Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

Day 4: Hanoi City Tour Full Day - Danang - Hoian

Day 5: Hoian Tour – Tra Que village

Continue your bicycle journey along the De Vong River to Hoi An Beach wharf. From there, board a boat to Cua Dai Sand Dune, where you'll enjoy a captivating casting net show and learn the art of casting a net from a local fisherman. Continue to Cam Thanh Water Coconut Village, where you'll receive a brief introduction to its history.

Embark on a basket boat adventure along the water coconut river, with fishermen teaching you how to catch crabs (two passengers per boat). Engage in a friendly competition as the group is divided into two teams for a thrilling basket boat race and crab-catching challenge, with a delightful prize awaiting the winners.

At 12:20 PM, board a boat and enjoy a folk songs show by local performers. Then, at 12:30 PM, savor special local delicacies, including pancakes, Tam Huu spring rolls, fried fish, and more. After lunch, learn to craft amusing tools from water coconut leaves.

At 2:00 PM, continue to the ancient town of Hoi An, where you'll experience the daily life of fishermen along the Thu Bon River. A walking tour of Hoi An's well-preserved ancient town center will transport you back in time to when it was a major trading port in Asia. Explore old shophouses, the 400-year-old Japanese Bridge, a Chinese communal hall, and the vibrant market. Conclude your day with free time to relax on Cua Dai Beach.

During your visit, explore various local workshops and witness the time-honored techniques employed by the local artisans to craft their products. Marvel at the production of activated charcoal, the artistry of dried coconut, the ingenuity behind handy coconut husk brooms, and the intricate creations fashioned from coir, or coconut fiber, by family businesses. Cruise along village roads aboard a "Xe Lôì," a local motorized rickshaw, to immerse yourself in the authentic charm of the region.
