## Detailed Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrival Bangkok



Upon arrival, you will be met outside the baggage claim area by your guide who will escort you to a waiting vehicle for your transfer to downtown with a brief introduction en route. Your guide will be holding a welcome signboard with the ASIA TOUR ADVISOR LOGO & your name.

During the drive your guide will provide an introduction to Bangkok. Bangkok is situated on the banks of the Chao Phraya River, Bangkok, also known as the City of Angels, is a vibrant city with many and varied charms. From grand historic buildings to peaceful temples, from

exciting markets to ritzy shopping malls and from towering skyscrapers to Chinese shop-houses, Bangkok is cosmopolitan and full of sharp contrasts..

## Day 2: Bangkok City Tour



Morning visit of the ROYAL PALACE, founded in 1782 by King Rama I. Located on Sanam Luang, west of Bangkok near the Chao River Phraya, the Royal Palace is the former royal residence of the dynasty from CHAKRI. This inner city of five hectares, surrounded by a austere wall, encloses gardens, temples and palaces.

The roofs to multiple sections with green and orange tiles, the chedis covered with glittering gold leaves, pillars encrusted with mosaics multicolored, contribute to the magic of the place. You will discover the WAT PHRA KEO, which is in fact the royal chapel of big palace.

The Emerald Buddha, which measures only 60 cm, is the most famous and most revered statue of Thailand. After that transfer to SIAM PARAGON to visit SEA LIFE OCEAN WORLD - one of the largest aquariums in the world and KIDZANI - a center for children aged 4-14 to learn and play in a safe environment, in the heart of Bangkok. It really is unique because it has its own airport, bank, hospital, theater, streets, shops and buildings with vehicles and pedestrians interact together, just like the real world. **\*\*Super Package\*\***. Return to the hotel at the end of the day

### **Day 3: Bangkok - Royal Palace - Aquatic Park Pororo**



Morning, meet our guide and drive to explore the Chao Phraya River's edge, to board a local style "Long Tail Boat", and spend a few hours to enjoy the old canals of the Thonburi side of Bangkok, where an older and more gracious lifestyle still prevails. You will have opportunities to snack, purchase knick-knacks, or use a toilet, at stops en route.

Visit the Temple of Dawn (Wat Arun), which you will probably recognize, from its famous silhouette. In the afternoon you will have free time to Pororo water park. Located on top of Central Plaza Bangna (6th floor), Aquatic Park Pororo Bangkok extends over 10 000m<sup>2</sup> with a number of water slides, pools and areas with water features - all on the theme of the famous character Korean Pororo - the little penguin and his friends.

### **Day 4: Bangkok - Darnern Saduak - Floating market - Kanchanaburi**



Early in the morning, we drive southwest of Bangkok, visit the local market at Samut Songkram before driving to Darnern Saduak , a rural floating market. Stop for a long-tailed boat trip along the waterway to the picturesque floating market of Damnern Saduak. Then we continue the road to the city of Kanchanaburi .

Upon arrival, visit the World War II memorial including the Jeath War Museum, Cemetery. Lunch on your own in a floating restaurant next to the Kwai River Bridge. We continue to Wang Pho to feed wild monkeys. Then boarding for a train ride along the railway from death to the city for the night.

**Meals:** Breakfast at the dining lounge, Lunch at local favorite restaurant

**Accommodation:** Kanchanaburi hotels



**Day 5: Kanchanaburi - Ayutthaya**



After breakfast, transfer to visit the Erawan National Park, which is one of the most beautiful waterfalls in the kingdom. The falls owe their name to the elephant with 3 heads of the Hindu mythology which is said to have a certain similarity with its 7 levels over a distance of 2000 meters and 900 meters of uneven.

In a turquoise water you will swim among a multitude of small. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon transfer to Ayutthaya . The ancient city of Ayuthay is known as the "Venice of the East" because it lies along the Chao Phraya River, the tributaries that surround the province of Ayuthaya.

**Day 6: Ayutthaya - Bangkok - Flight to Chiang Rai**



Morning breakfast, visit of the most important ruined temples in the historical park of Ayutthaya: Wat Mahathat , Wat Yai Chai Mongkol , Wat Phra Si Sanphet , Viharn Phra Mongkhon Bophit and Wat Chaiwatthanaram .

You take the ride in the tuk tuk "Kermit" in the historical park. Kermit is a special type of motor vehicle available only in Ayutthaya and Trang. Lunch on your own and departure to Bangkok. Flight to Chiang Rai. Upon arrival meet with guide then transfer to check in at hotel.

**Meals:** Breakfast at the dining lounge, Lunch at local favorite restaurant

**Accommodation:** Chiang Rai hotels



## Day 7: Chiang Rai



After your breakfast, you will leave to explore the city and visit the white temple, Wat Rong Khun . Although this temple is very recent, it is the most visited monument in the region, the work of the Thai artist Chalermchai Kositpipat , started in 1997. Its creator himself announces that it will only be completed 60 to 90 years later his death. Its peculiarity is its immaculate whiteness.

Indeed, it is a unique temple of its kind. In the wihaan, a fresco blends Buddhist codes with Matrix, Star Wars, the Twin Towers attack in New York and even Kung-Fu Panda, which stands out from the usual decorations for such monuments. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon you can take a motorized canoe excursion on the Kok River and visit a Tibeto-Burmese village . Dinner on your own and possibility to visit the night market.

## Day 8: Chiang Rai - Golden Triangle



Breakfast. In Chiang Rai, you are in the confines of northern Thailand. A wooded, mountainous and beautiful area. This morning, you will explore the surroundings and the first road you will take is the one that leads to Mae Salong .

Climb up and down the green hills, covered with tea plantations. You will taste the delicious tea produced by one of the many plantations of the region, before continuing your road towards the Golden Triangle . From Doi Mae Salong, you will visit two villages of ethnic minorities: the village Akah of Loyo, and the village Lisu of Ban Haygo .

**Meals:** Breakfast at the dining lounge, Lunch at local favorite restaurant

**Accommodation:** Chiang Rai hotels



**Day 9: Golden Triangle - Thaton - Chiang Mai**



After breakfast, you will leave the hotel to get to Thaton . You will make a stop on the way to the village of Patai to meet the tribe Padong Karen, famous for its women "giraffes" who wear copper rings around their neck to lengthen it.

You will then discover a traditional Chinese medicine pharmacy where an expert will explain the use of herbs, roots, plants and ointments. In the afternoon, take the road to Chiang Mai, the capital of the North, and stop for a walk in the maze of underground galleries in Chiang Dao . Then you will be at your hotel at the end of the day.

**Day 10: Chiang Mai**



Breakfast. The morning will be mainly devoted to the walking tour of the old town with a stop at the old wall, the moat and a door of the old town. You will see the most beautiful temples of Chiang Mai: Wat Prah Singh temple, Wat Phan Tao temple, Wat Chedi Luang temple .

Then you will stroll along small streets lined with traditional houses, where you will make a tour in a rickshaw . From here, you will go to the central market of Warorot. In the afternoon you will visit the Doi Suthep hill . To brighten up your evening, browse the Night Market for yourself.

**Day 11: Chiang Mai - Elephant Camp - Overnight Train to Bangkok**



This day aims to explore Elephant Nature Park - a natural home and sanctuary for elephants, buffalos, dogs, cats, birds and many other rescued animals. Your visit starts with a picturesque drive through rural countryside. You will hear the personal stories of rescued and orphaned elephants. See how they became a proud herd and free from abuse for the first time in their lives. Many find their visit to Elephant Nature Park rewarding and very relaxing. Observe free roaming elephants (NO RIDING), and other rescued animals enjoying the natural surroundings of our sanctuary. Your visit helps support our regional projects and offers an invaluable opportunity of helping elephant conservation. You will join various activities to cherish the elephants (unload, distribute fruit treats and feed the elephants from the viewing platform).

Enjoy a sumptuous and varied vegetarian buffet of Asian and International dishes in the beautiful nature of the park

Walk with our staff and the elephants to the river that skirts the park. Watch these gentle giants as they splash around and play while you stay dry on the river bank. After the visit, it's time for goodbyes to the elephants and to Elephant Nature Park before the hour-long drive back to Chiang Mai. You will have some free time until our driver transfers you to the train station. The Overnight train will embark in Bangkok.

*\*Park visits are all about spending quality time observing, being with the herd and be their friends (RIDING IS NOT ALLOWED). We do not adhere to a strict schedule; the best way to make the most of your visit is to relax, watch and learn from the elephants.*
