Day 6: Ninh Binh Discovery – Hanoi

Your journey continues to the ancient capital of Vietnam, Hoa Lu. Delve into history as you visit the Ding King Temple and the Le King Temple, both dating back to the 10th century. These hallowed grounds tell the heroic tales of these kings during the Chinese Wars.

Next, you'll venture to Mua Cave, a place steeped in fascinating stories. Climb 500 stone steps to reach its summit, where a breathtaking panoramic view of the countryside and Ngo Dong River awaits, stretching out as far as Tam Coc.

As the day unfolds, you'll be transported back to Hanoi, where you can savor some free time at your leisure.
