Day 1: Danang Arrival - A Warm Welcome to Vietnam

Day 2: Exploring Hoi An's Enchanting Tra Que Village



Embark on a captivating journey to Tra Que Village, where your local guide awaits you at 8:00 AM, bicycles ready. You'll pedal through the scenic countryside to reach this charming village, where you'll immerse yourself in its vibrant culture. Stroll through vegetable gardens and join local farmers in preparing the fertile land, enriching it with seaweed from the nearby lake. Engage in various gardening activities, from raking the earth to sowing, watering, and harvesting fresh vegetables.

After these enriching experiences, take a well-deserved break and enjoy a soothing foot bath. Then, join a local family to prepare your lunch, featuring an array of local delicacies such as 'tam huu' spring rolls and 'Banh xeo,' a local pancake beloved by the people of the central region of Vietnam. The chef will guide you through the cooking process. Following your morning adventures and a delectable meal, savor a traditional Vietnamese post-prandial nap before learning the art of harvesting and wrapping vegetables. At around 1:00 PM, bid farewell to your gracious host family and cycle back to Hoi An. The afternoon is yours to explore the picturesque Hoi An Old Quarter, with a walking tour that will transport you back in time to its days as a bustling Asian trading port. Visit ancient shophouses, the iconic 400-year-old Japanese Bridge, Chinese communal halls, and the vibrant local market. Conclude your day with some free time to relax on Cua Dai Beach.

Day 3: Hoi An to Hue: A Scenic Journey

Along the way, pause to explore the Cham Museum, ascend the Ocean Clouds Pass for breathtaking panoramic views, and visit the charming Lang Co Beach fishing village. Upon your arrival in Hue, check in at your hotel and unwind at your own pace.

Day 4: Discovering the Imperial Majesty of Hue



Commence your day with a visit to the Imperial Citadel, a magnificent structure where the Nguyen Dynasty held sway from 1802 to 1945. Explore the remnants of this grand monument, and then embark on a cyclo tour through the 'Old City' to Tinh Tam Lake, where the Emperors would retreat for relaxation. In the afternoon, your adventure continues with a visit to Mu Pagoda, perched overlooking the Perfume River. Conclude the day at Khai Dinh's Tomb, a unique blend of traditional Vietnamese design with a European influence, setting it apart from the other royal tombs in Hue.

Day 5: Biking to Thuy Bieu Village: An Immersive Cultural Experience



Today, depart from the city center and embark on a cycling journey to Thuy Bieu Village, following the southern bank of the Perfume River. Your ride begins in the city's lively hub but quickly leads you into a more tranquil setting. Discover the Tiger Fighting Arena, a historic site where elephants and tigers once engaged in combat for the amusement of the Emperor, the royal family, and mandarins. Continuing your journey, visit the Elephant Temple, a sacred site where the King's war elephants are laid to rest and honored.

Your route then takes you to Thuy Bieu Village, where you'll have the opportunity to observe silk painting craftsmanship by local artisans. As you cycle along verdant paths within Thuy Bieu Village, unwind and immerse yourself in the scenic beauty. Partake in the age-old tradition of making incense sticks, a crucial element in Buddhist rituals, ancestor anniversaries in Hue, and general worship. Engage in crafting 'banh nam' and 'banh loc,' special Hue cakes, under the guidance of your host. As the day unfolds, you'll have the chance to taste your culinary creations. Conclude your cycling journey as you leave Thuy Bieu Village by dragon boat, arriving at Toa Kham Boat Dock in the city center. You'll then return to your hotel by bicycle, with free time to relax.

Day 6: A Glimpse of Hue's History: Vinh Moc Tunnels and More



After departing from your hotel, the journey will take you through Quang Tri Province. Your destination is the remarkable Vinh Moc Tunnels, an untouched and authentic glimpse into underground life. Explore the subterranean passages that reveal a piece of history. Afterwards, you'll drive to Dong Hoi Town, where you'll enjoy dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 7: Phong Nha-Kẻ Bàng National Park: A Natural Wonder



Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at your hotel. Your guide will then accompany you on a tour to the awe-inspiring Phong Nha caves, located approximately 50 kilometers from the city, a scenic 45-minute drive. A 25-minute boat ride will bring you to Phong Nha Cave, aptly named the "Water Cave," famous for its remarkable rock formations, each with a unique name such as the "Lion," the "Fairy Caves," the "Royal Court," and the "Buddha."

Lunch will be served at a local restaurant in Phong Nha village before you set off to explore the National Park in the afternoon. There's a special tip for those traveling during the summer months, from April to August: bring your swimsuit and a towel for a refreshing swim. The tour continues with a visit to Paradise Cave, the longest dry cave in Asia, situated within the Phong Nha-Kẻ Bàng National Park's core zone, 25 kilometers from Phong Nha Cave, 75 kilometers from Dong Hoi, and a 1-hour and 20-minute drive away. You'll have the remainder of the day to explore this extraordinary cave. After this adventure, you'll be transferred to your hotel, where you can check in and unwind, enjoying some free time.
