Many of Hoi An's historic structures were constructed by their forebears during the town's peak as a commercial port. In Kim Bong Village, you'll witness artisans practicing their craft and visit

ship-building yards. The craftsmanship of Kim Bong Carpentry combines the influences of the Cham Kingdom, China, Japan, and Vietnam, brought to life by the skilled hands of Vietnamese craftsmen. The journey concludes as you return to Hoi An by boat.

Day 3: Hoi An Countryside Exploration with Cooking and Biking

In the afternoon, bid farewell to your host family before embarking on a bicycle ride to the fishing village and water coconut forest in Cam Thanh. This village, which served as a refuge during the Vietnam War, is now renowned for its seafood production. Upon reaching the village, fishermen will guide you in traditional bamboo basket boats, providing insights into their unique fishing methods. Cycle back to your hotel after an eventful day.
