Day 1: Hanoi - Nghia Lo: Embracing Heritage and Culture



At around 8:00 am, your adventure with AsiaTourAdvisor begins as our expert guide and driver pick you up for the journey to Nghia Lo. En route, we'll pause to explore the historic Duong Lam village, a national architectural treasure. Here, centuries-old traditional Vietnamese houses stand as a testament to the country's rich heritage. We delve into the village, visiting a typical house, and immersing ourselves in local architecture and traditions.

Our scenic drive then continues towards Yen Bai, where we venture into the realm of the Thai minority. In the afternoon, we embark on a walk to a Thai village characterized by houses perched on stilts. Here, amidst this charming community, we capture the essence of daily life through our camera lens. Your overnight stay awaits in Nghia Lo.

Day 2: Nghia Lo - Mu Cang Chai: The Road Less Traveled



Awaken to the serenity of Nghia Lo and savor an early breakfast. A visit to the town's vibrant market will immerse you in the local culture as tribal people bring forth their fresh produce and goods. Our journey then takes us further north, stopping by a picturesque Thai village along the way, where we'll photograph the captivating Thai community in their stilted houses.

Continuing our path, we reach Tu Le, a charming mountain town renowned across the country for its sticky rice. Here, we indulge in local specialties for lunch before further exploring a deep valley adorned with terraced rice fields.

In the afternoon, we drive onward to Mu Cang Chai, a pristine, non-touristy mountain town. Check in to our homestay and relish the refreshing mountain air.

Day 3: Mu Cang Chai Trekking: Capturing Nature's Beauty



Today, we venture into the heart of Mu Cang Chai's stunning landscapes. We begin our journey with an uphill walk, eventually reaching a valley where vibrant rice terraces extend as far as the eye can see. Opportunities to capture the breathtaking scenery, replete with locals diligently harvesting their crops, abound.

After a well-deserved lunch break at a local restaurant, we continue to explore a nearby H'Mong minority village nestled amid the hills. Here, we engage with the locals, gaining insights into their daily lives. Your evening is free to savor your dinner and rest in Mu Cang Chai.

Day 4: Mu Cang Chai - Tan Uyen - Sapa: Hidden Treasures Await



This morning, we set out for another valley close to Mu Cang Chai town, offering a panoramic view of the entire town enveloped by terraced rice fields. The morning presents perfect photo opportunities, capturing water buffaloes and villagers engaged in rice harvesting.

Our journey continues from Mu Cang Chai to Than Uyen, where we'll enjoy lunch. Subsequently, we embark on a trek to the rice fields, photographing the Thai minority as they gather their rice crops. After a 40-kilometer drive to Tan Uyen, we venture into a hidden tea plantation, where locals hand-pick tea leaves against a backdrop of breathtaking scenery.

Finally, we proceed to the enchanting town of Sapa, where you'll have the afternoon to explore the town's market and enjoy free time. Overnight in Sapa.

What's included: Private car transfer, English-speaking guide, breakfast, lunch, dinner, entrance fees, overnight at a hotel in Sapa.

Meals: Breakfast at the dining lounge, Lunch/Dinner at local favorite restaurant

Day 5: Sapa - Lao Chai – Ta Van: Cultural Encounters



After breakfast and hotel check-out, prepare for your Sapa adventure. We begin our trek, embarking on a 20-minute walk through the town before veering onto a dirt road leading to Ma Tra Village. Here, the Black H'Mong ethnic community thrives. We continue our journey through the village, down to the Muong Hoa River along Y Linh Ho valley, and arrive at Lao Chai village, home to the Black H'Mong people.

The Black H'Mong are one of the prominent minority groups in the Sapa region, known for their rich culture and traditions. They don distinctive indigo blue clothing and boast their own language.

We continue our trek to Ta Van village (1,200 m), home to the Zay people. The Zay minority, with a population of around 38,000, primarily inhabit the mountainous regions of Northwest Vietnam. Although modernization has impacted some of their traditional customs, many women still adorn themselves with traditional shirts in vibrant shades of purple, blue, or green.

Check in at your room before enjoying a leisurely one-hour party for dinner, accompanied by music and the chance to savor some local wine and soft drinks.

Day 6: Ta Van – Giang Ta Chai - Sapa: Journey's End



Following breakfast among the locals, marvel at the stunning morning scenery. Leave the village behind and continue to the picturesque Muong Hoa River, where you'll have the opportunity to capture photos of the river, lush rice terraces, water buffalos, and villagers immersed in the rice harvesting process.

We then bid farewell to Mu Cang Chai and head for Than Uyen, a town celebrated for its vibrant sticky rice dishes. Savor your lunch here before embarking on a hidden tea plantation adventure. The landscape is nothing short of breathtaking, with tea plantations stretching to the horizon.

Our journey culminates in Sapa, where you'll have free time in the late afternoon to explore the town's market and indulge in personal pursuits. Overnight in Sapa.

What's included: Private car transfer, English-speaking guide, breakfast, lunch, dinner, entrance fees, overnight at a hotel in Sapa.

Day 7: Sapa – Ma Tra – Ta Phin - Hanoi: Reflecting on Memories



After breakfast and hotel check-out, set out on a walk through the town for approximately 20 minutes before embarking on a dirt road to Ma Tra Village. Here, the Black H'Mong ethnic group resides, offering a unique opportunity to witness their daily lives.

Continuing our journey, we pass through paddies fields to reach an ancient Catholic abbey constructed during the French colonial era. Walk an additional 2 km to arrive at Ta Phin Village, where you'll explore the daily lives of the Red Dzaio ethnic group. This is an excellent opportunity for souvenir shopping, as you can acquire hand-made textiles and brocades created by the local people.

We'll have lunch at a local restaurant before returning to Hanoi, where you will reach your hotel at approximately 7:00 pm.
